Olde City Slate

Cast from the time-aged sidewalks of our country's oldest city streets, this pattern is comprised of medium-textured rectangular stones. Can be laid in running bond or random formation.



Random Flagstone

Random width rectangular slate with stones varying from 4" to 20".
